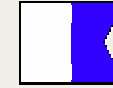

“C” level service includes Levels A & B. With this service I will sit down with you and determine what additional services you may require. I will be available to provision your boat for the weekend or trip prior to your arrival. Fueling services are available as are maintenance scheduling and additional managerial services.
